Rechartering- Rob Dugan is updating our current registered list. He is deleting boys and/or adults that do not need to be counted towards our count this upcoming year. At this time it appears that we have a current count of 23 Youths and 14 adults that will be part of our number. Mr. Penney motioned to the committee if adults could pay for their own \$24.00 yearly cost, as this is costing \$336.00 from Troop 49's account. It was discussed and then amended since some of the adults have 2 family members volunteering their time and service to Troop 49. It was discussed that perhaps a family that has 2 members volunteering (Colberts and Dugans) pay only one \$24.00 fee and troop cover the other cost. It

was also amended that an adult would pay for the cost if financially able. This matter was decided to be tabled and discussed in March when all members of the committee were present.

## **New Business:**

Mr. Penney would like to purchase 2 new tents for the troop, especially since we are gaining 5 new boys in March Crossover. He presented a good deal at Walmart with free shipping cost would be \$72.00 per tent. We voted and agreed for Mr. Penney to get these tents with a budget not to exceed \$150.00.

Troop 49 also needs to purchase or have Lee Colbert make new Troop 49 neckerchiefs there are only 3 left in the garage. Lee will look into cost of blanks and let troop know the cost. Mr. Penney was interested in at least 5 and possibly 10 since some boys have inquired about purchasing a new one.
